Control Your Electric Fencing with Your Mobile Phone!

*Two years ago, we introduced a range of **IP Energisers** that allow you to control your electric fence installation with your mobile phone. You can program these energisers in such a way that they send you an alarm if the voltage on the fence is below the level you have programmed. You do no longer have to put the voltmeter on the fence, you simply turn on your mobile phone and it tells you what the current reading is. It is as simple as this.*

We have now three IP energisers of different Output Joule rating on the market i.e. 8, 12 and 16 Joules. These are competitively priced.

- **Red Trout LIMB80 IP 8 Output Joules up to 80 km of fence \$ 695.00 incl. GST**
- **Red Trout LIMB120 IP 12 Output Joules up to 100 km of fence \$ 815.00 incl. GST**
- **Red Trout LIMB160 IP 16 Output Joules up to 160 km of fence \$ 990.00 incl. GST**

These three energisers are each approx. 30 % more economical than those of our competitors, and they do not offer the IP facility. Check out our website www.redsnapr.co.nz for more details and price comparisons.



*Those of you who already have the necessary energisers but would like to have the above facilities, you can upgrade your energisers with an **IP Monitor**. This relatively new development changes an ordinary fence into a **Monitored Electric Fence**. This means that you can check the voltage of your fence on your mobile phone and you can turn off the power to the fence. The **IP Monitor** is compatible with all energisers from major suppliers. There are two models available:*

- **Red Trout IP Monitor (up to 16 Output Joules) \$ 398.50 incl. GST**
- **Red Trout IP Monitor (up to 36 Output Joules) \$ 488.50 incl. GST**



*By the way the **IP Monitor** can also be used with lower powered energisers (5 joules or lower) or in combination with a solar powered energiser. That would then look like this:*

This is a very handy combination since such units are usually quite away from home and checking the voltage on the fence via your mobile phone would save you a considerable amount of time.
